

Pediatric Critical Care Resident Role on the PACE Team
Can MEDS Roles and Competencies

Role	Competency
Medical Expert	<p>PACE functions largely in a consultative capacity requiring development of critical care expertise to help identify and provide advice relating to management, diagnosis and treatment of potential critical care issues</p> <p>Further develop critical care assessment skills aided by working closely with other critical care health care providers</p>
Communicator	<p>Develop ability to effectively communicate with team members, other services and families</p> <p>Further develop ability to organize, synthesize and communicate relevant critical care information efficiently</p>
Collaborator	<p>Requires the ability to collaboratively arrive at joint decisions with other health care professionals and help to anticipate and diffuse potential conflict</p>
Manager	<p>Become familiar with the rationale behind critical care response teams with respect to improving access to critical care resources by reducing preventable critical care admissions</p> <p>Become more aware of potential hospital patient safety or quality of care issues through participation with the PACE team</p>
Scholar	<p>Residents are encouraged to participate in the education role of the PACE team and help facilitate learning of other health care professionals and families</p>
Professional	<p>Experience impact of better continuity of care following critical care discharges on patients and accepting health care providers</p>
