

## **CBL Guide**

1. Each file has a case and several articles attached.
2. The objectives are pre-defined in the case.
3. You may not be able to complete all the objectives, you should decide as a group, which are the main objectives you will cover.
4. It is recommended that you read the case and article in advance.
5. There are usually two or three resource articles included or a link provided.
  - a. Pediatric resident should try and read all the articles.
  - b. Off service learners should read at least the top 2 articles.
  - c. Medical students should read at least one of the articles.
6. Teams one and two should try and do the cases together during the Friday morning assigned time slot and at other times as time permits.
7. The CBL session should be run by one of the following in the order listed:
  - a. SPR
  - b. Fellow
  - c. JPR
  - d. Staff
8. As the case is read the facilitator should pause along the way for discussion, this will help facilitate covering the objectives.
