



Program Descriptions

Enough is Enough is a nationwide campaign created to address and stem violence on the nation's campuses. It is designed to "create a new paradigm for peace and safety by addressing the societal violence that has contributed to unprecedented violence in some of the very places our students should feel most safe." Dr. Barbara Henley, the Vice Chancellor of Student Affairs, sought to bring this important message of peace to the University of Illinois at Chicago. Dr. Henley charged the UIC Wellness Center with the mission of inviting key Student Affairs, Campus Departments / Units, and student organizations to serve on the *Enough are Enough* Committee. The collaborative efforts of Committee Members, their units, and their student organizations have culminated in an incredible week of "Enough is Enough" program events and activities.

The UIC *Enough is Enough* theme is "Peace, Respect, Community, UIC." What makes this week especially remarkable is how this theme is brought to life in a variety of creative, civic, and educational programs. For example, Single Student Residence Hall will have Teresa Sullivan, a Ph.D. student and resident of SSR who is completing her dissertation on violence in our culture, will give a presentation to SSR residents. The creativity continues with the Gender and Sexuality Center using this week to premier its film "It Gets Better / Make it Better." Produced by GSC, in collaboration with other campus office, this film features UIC GBLT students, faculty, and staff offering words of strength and inspiration. Spreading the message of "peace", the Office of the Dean of Students, will connect the campus during this week by distributing over two hundred peace posters on the east and west side of campus. James Stukel Tower is focusing on "community" and collaborating with the Chicago Children Advocacy Center (CCAC) to host a "penny war" that will raise money to support children of the CCAC.
