Benefits of the Program

Effective July 1, 2007

Courses

- PALS** required to be completed in the first 3 months of training \$340 (includes text) per resident – covered by the program PG reimburses program \$325/resident \$200 for re-certification (does not include text) covered by the program PG does not reimburse program for recerts
- APLS** course is not a requirement of the program and therefore cost is not covered
- ATLS** required to be completed by the end of 1st year of training \$710 per resident resident pays cost directly and is reimbursed by Peter Steer's office
- NRP** required to be completed in the first year of training recertification in senior year costs covered by the program

Dues

- AAP** \$95 US annually per resident covered by the program
- CPS** \$55 annually per resident covered by the program

Exams

- ABP IT** \$65 US annually for R1, R2 and R3s covered by the program
- Mock OSCEs, MCQ, SAQ** 2 x per year – costs covered by the program
- Long Case Exam** 2 x per year – cost to hold exams covered by the program
- Exam Prep** for R4s

Conference/Travel

\$3,000 per resident over core training, an additional \$1,000 per resident in fourth year provided by the program additional funding provided to residents upon approval for research presentations

Faculty Development

required to be completed in fourth year of training cost of the course covered by the program
