

## PEM EDUCATION OVERVIEW

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### EDUCATIONAL INITIATIVES AND GOALS

#### **1. *Weekly rounds***

All faculty from the Division of PEM will be required to present a one hour session. These rounds will be accredited by the College of Family Physicians and the Royal College.

Attendance will be mandatory for all housestaff and attendance will be taken. Absence will be marked by the post-graduate and undergraduate coordinators as lapses in professionalism domain of CanMEDS.

Residents will be asked to also present a case presentation each week after the session.

#### **2. *Mock codes***

Inter-professional sessions to be coordinated among the post-graduate and under-graduate coordinators.

Sessions will take place every two weeks.

#### **3. *Practice exams***

Practice exam sessions for the CCFP-EM, FRCP-EM, and the FRCP-Peds residents.

Expected start date: January 2011

#### **4. *Rounds presentations to other Divisions and Departments***

Facilitated and organized by the Education lead.

Lectures and seminars to undergraduate and post-graduate groups.

FRCP-EM and CCFP-EM sessions to begin September 2010.

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### POST-GRADUATE AND UNDERGRADUATE DEVELOPMENTS

As of July 2010, undergraduate and postgraduate trainees will begin to rotate through the Department. Other allied health trainees will also begin to come throughout the year, and we are getting requests from many others including the NP and midwifery programs.
