

## Pediatric Hematology/Oncology Clinic Information for Medical Students and Clinical Clerks

The pediatric hematology/oncology clinic is located in the 3F area and operates Monday to Friday from 9am – 12:30 pm. The Wednesday morning clinic is hematology oriented, while the remaining clinics are oncology oriented.

The pediatric hematology/oncology clinic will provide first hand experience into how a multidisciplinary team manages patients with complex medical issues.

In general, clinics will provide you with the opportunities to learn how to complete a focused history and physical examination, and assess whether a child is sick.

Oncology clinics will provide you with the opportunity to:

- Observe patients with common pediatric malignancies
- Understand complications arising from therapy
- Learn basic principals of oncology therapy

Hematology clinics will provide you with the opportunity to:

- Observe patients with common hematologic conditions
- Understand appropriate investigations for hematologic conditions
- Learn basic principals of hematologic therapy

Although the clinic is very busy, there is a dedicated team of health care professionals that will help you to learn. These include physicians, nurses, pharmacists, dieticians and social workers.
